We have enclosed some very important forms for you to fill out. Please be as accurate, thorough and thoughtful as possible. Please remember to bring this paperwork with you to your appointment. If you need to reschedule your appointment, we ask that you give us at least 24 hours notice.

Please plan to arrive for your initial visit at least 10-15 minutes before your appointment. Allow some extra time to locate the office. When you arrive, we will take your completed paperwork and assemble a chart. We will need to make a copy of your insurance card and driver's license. In most cases, we will call your insurance company for verification of coverage, benefits and exclusions (services and/or items your insurance will not allow). You are responsible for deductibles, co-pays, co-insurance and non-covered services and/or items; and are due at the time of service. Ultimately, your insurance coverage is between you and your insurance company.

Please wear comfortable clothing for your visit. It is best to wear shorts or pants that can be easily moved up to your knees to allow the doctor to examine your ankles and legs, if necessary. Sometimes our office is rather cool, so bring a sweater or wrap if you chill easily. If you are uncomfortable for any reason, please let us know. We want your visit to be as pleasant as possible.

Please refrain from wearing strong perfume/cologne, as allergies are a problem for others in the office. Cell phones must be turned off when in the exam rooms. Children under the age of 18 are not permitted in the exam rooms unless they are the patient.
